

FAQ | Albatros Web Service (AWS) / Golf Club TV Image and Video Formats Supported by Golf Club TV

Images, slideshows, or videos can be uploaded into Golf Club TV and added to the playlist.

1. Uploading images

All standard image formats, supported by most web browsers, can be uploaded into Golf Club TV. This applies in particular to the following image file formats:

- > JPG
- ➤ TIF
- PNG
- BMP
- ➢ GIF

We preferably recommend JPG files. Files exceeding 3-4 MB should be avoided if possible.

2. Uploading videos

Golf Club TV provides two different elements to display moved images. The element "VIDEO" currently supports the following video formats:

- > FLV (H.263)
- > MP4 (H.264)
- > F4V (H.264)
- MOV (H.264)
- M4A (H.264)
- > 3GP (H.264)

Moreover, the element "FLASH" allows for the uploading of flash films into the system. These files are employed in the format "SWF".

Large data volumes of video files might lead to extremely long loading times both during the uploading and playing and should thus be avoided.

3. Uploading slideshow

A complete slideshow can also be displayed on Golf Club TV. Prior to the show's use in the system, it must be created and saved outside the system in one of the above mentioned video formats.
